PRIVACY STATEMENT

At Chapel Ministries, Inc., we understand that privacy is important, and we are strongly committed to protecting the privacy of donors and visitors to our website. The following information is designed to help you better understand the information we gather from our site and through our services, how we handle the information once we gather it, whether we disclose it to anyone, and the choices you have regarding our use of the information

How Chapel Ministries, Inc. Uses and Collects Information About You

Our primary goals in collecting personal information are to provide you with a smooth, efficient, and customized experience, to send you information upon your request, and to facilitate your ability to support our ministry.

AGGREGATE DATA

We automatically gather certain usage information, such as the number and frequency of visitors to this site. This collective data helps us determine how much our visitors use parts of the site, and do internal research on our users' demographics, interests, and behavior to better understand and serve you. In these situations, we do not disclose any information that could be used to identify you personally.

For example, we use session ID cookies. Usage of a cookie is in no way linked to any personally identifiable information while on our website. A cookie is a piece of data stored on a user's computer tied to information about the user. A session ID cookie is terminated once a user closes their browser. We use this information to measure the amount of traffic on our website. We use such data only in the aggregate. We do not, however, use persistent cookies (small text files stored on a website user's hard drive for an extended period of time).

PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION

General. There are pages on this site where we request personally identifiable information about you such as your name, address, phone number, credit/debit card number and email address. We seek such information in order to process your donations.

Donations. If you choose to donate to Chapel Ministries, Incorporated, once you complete a transaction we will use your email address to send you an electronic receipt for your records.

Other Uses. We employ other companies and individuals to perform functions on our behalf to process credit card payments and provide customer service. These companies and individuals have access to personal information needed to perform their functions, but may not use it for any other purpose.

How We May Share Information

We will not sell, share or rent information about you in ways different from what is disclosed in this statement. However, we may be forced to disclose information to the government or third parties under certain circumstances. We cooperate with law enforcement inquiries, as well as other third parties, to enforce laws such as those regarding intellectual property rights, fraud and other personal rights. We can (and you authorize us to) disclose any information about you to law enforcement or other government officials as we, in our sole discretion, believe necessary or appropriate in connection with an investigation of fraud, intellectual property infringement or other activity that is illegal or may expose us, or you, to liability.

Our Policy Toward Children

We are concerned about the safety and privacy of children who use the Internet. Although we encourage children to learn more about our organization and opportunities to serve their communities, we encourage that this be done with parental supervision. Consistent with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998, we will never knowingly request personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 13 without prior verifiable parental consent. If we become aware that a child under 13 has provided us with personally identifiable information without verifiable parental consent, we will use our best efforts to remove such information from our files.
